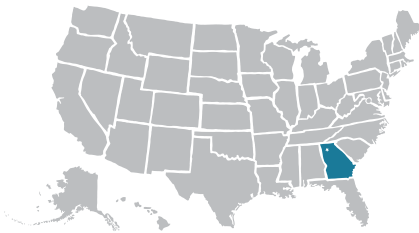

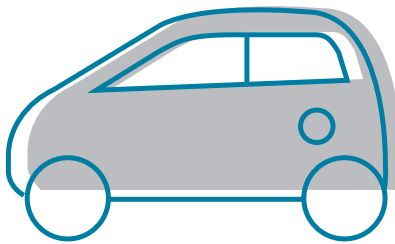
According to Georgia PSC 2026 summer Residential Rate Survey

- Each month, Cobb EMC members' **bills are \$40 lower** than the average utility bill in the state among 41 EMCs.

- Since 2013, Cobb EMC has given back **\$86 million** in power cost adjustments (PCA) to members.

- Cobb EMC's investment grade rating of **A+ by Fitch Ratings** confirms the strong financial profile of the company.

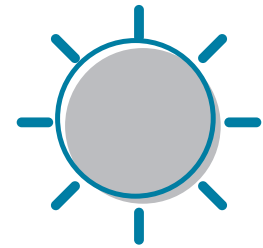
