C. High school transcript (Can be unofficial or official).

D. Provide one letter of recommendation, relatives excluded, to explain why you should be considered a scholarship recipient. Examples: Professional, Church Youth Group Leader, Community Leader, etc. Enclose the recommendation letters with your application. **Please do not include a photo or resume with your application.**

E. Copy of S.A.T., or A.C.T score. If you did not take the S.A.T. or A.C.T., you may submit Accuplacer scores (Unofficial or Official).

Cobb EMC Foundation College/University Scholarship Criteria

1. The recipient's primary residence must be the household of a Cobb EMC member.
2. The recipient must be enrolled in an accredited high school program, either full-time or part-time.
3. The recipient must be a High School Senior.
4. The scholarship funds will be paid to the scholarship recipient.
5. The scholarship fund will provide \$5,000 for each scholarship winner's educational expenses.
6. The scholarship may be used at any two-year or four-year accredited college or university.
7. A combination of academic ability, character qualities, and community involvement will be used on a weighted scale in determining scholarship fund winners.
8. Cobb EMC's Foundation Board will oversee and administer the scholarship funding.
9. Scholarship winners must notify the Cobb EMC Coordinator of their acceptance of the award and the name of the school they will attend by June 1st, or they will forfeit the scholarship.
10. Scholarship finalists will be invited to and must attend a formal interview process.
11. Scholarship applicants will receive an email notice or phone call that their application was received.
12. A scholarship committee will select the winners by the end of May.
13. The 2025 scholarship winners will be announced on the Cobb EMC corporate website.
14. Cobb EMC employees and their children **are not** eligible for this scholarship.
15. Cobb EMC Directors and their children **are not** eligible for this scholarship.
16. Applications must be **postmarked** no later than **February 20, 2026**.
