Cobb EMC Electrical Line Worker Scholarship Criteria

1. The scholarship recipient's primary residence must be within Cobb, Bartow, Cherokee, Fulton, or Paulding Counties.
2. The scholarship applicant must be a 2025/2026 school year high school graduate.
3. Scholarship applicants will receive an email or phone call that their application was received.
4. The scholarship fund will provide up to \$25,000 for educational expenses at an approved Line Worker School. See #5 for a list of pre-approved schools.
5. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to an approved Line Worker School. Cobb EMC authorizes the following schools.
 - Elite Lineman Training Institute – Elite
 - Southeastern Lineman Training Center – SLTC
6. A combination of academic ability, character, community involvement, and the autobiographical sketch will be used to select scholarship winners. Scholarship finalists will be invited to and must attend a formal interview process.
7. A Selection Committee designated by Cobb EMC will oversee and administer scholarship funding.
8. Scholarship winners must notify Cobb EMC officials of their acceptance of the award and provide the name of the school they plan to attend. A school that is not pre-approved by Cobb EMC may be submitted for consideration. The decisions of the selection committee are final.
9. A scholarship selection committee will choose the winner by the end of July.
10. The scholarship winner will be announced on the Cobb EMC corporate website.
11. Cobb EMC employees and their children **are not** eligible for this scholarship.
12. Cobb EMC Directors and their children **are not** eligible for this scholarship.
13. Mailed applications must be **postmarked** no later than Friday, June 5, 2026.
